William Pontz served as general chairman for this year's party.

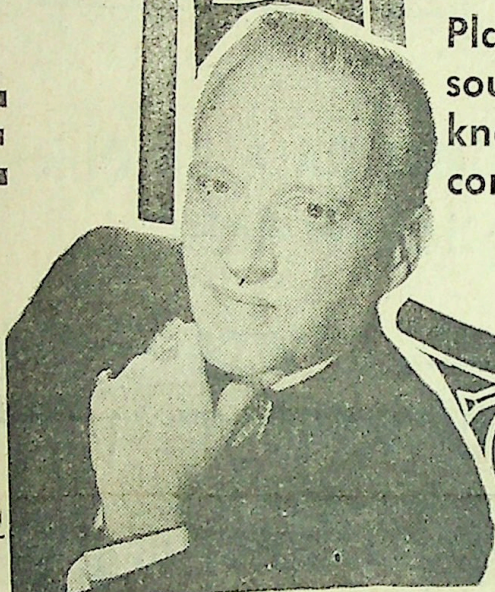

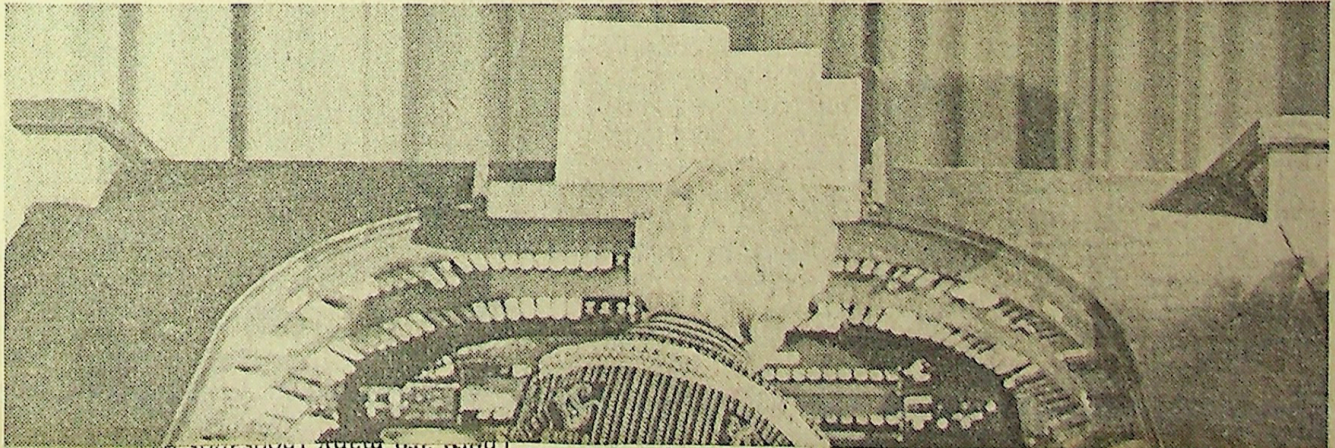

State to Add Organ Music Next Sunday

'Bud' Taylor Back for Revived Feature.

Remember the "good old days" of organ music interludes at the downtown movie house?

Well, they're on their way back. Pat Heavey, manager of the State theatre, announced Saturday that organ music will again be a regular part of his theatre's program starting one week from today, Sunday, July 16.

Community sings and song slides between movie performances will be revived. The theatre's Barton organ, virtually unused for more than 13 years, is being overhauled by experts for the occasion.

HERE IN '30'S

The organist will be Frank E. "Bud" Taylor, a former Kalamazoo resident who was featured organist at the State for 2½ years back in the middle '30's.

Besides playing the Barton organ during intermissions, Taylor will be featured at his own electric organ in the theatre lobby, for the added entertainment of patrons.

Taylor is a Central high school graduate. He studied theatre and radio organ at the Sherwood School of Music in Chicago, and for a time after leaving the State theatre in 1937 operated his own music studio here.

Since leaving Kalamazoo, he had done extensive radio, hotel and night club work in St. Louis, Mo., New York City, and other cities.

HAD RADIO SHOWS

While in St. Louis a few years ago, he was heard on the coast-to-coast "Smoothies" show over the American Broadcasting Company network and was staff organist for Station KMOX.

For the last five years he has been in New York. Recent engagements have been at the Hotel Sheraton and Delmonico hotel, among others. He had a sustaining show over Station WNEW for 2½ years, and did some work for RKO theatres in New York City.

Taylor is the son of Frank F. Taylor, 710 Village street.

Painting the Town with Esquire



SOME want noise and nonsense with their evening nutrition. Some crave calm. Some, glamour-greedy, are goggle-eyed for notables and gloatables. Some are out to splurge and be salaamed to. Some ponder the chances of playing plutocrat on peanuts. Some desire to shake the hip. Some would sooner sit and stow sirloin, with a good cigar for dessert. Some seek seafood. Some itch to go exotic and sample strange dishes and fear-some-named drinks. To please everybody, this town would have to have spots for every conceivable taste—which is exactly what those demon hunchmen, New York's bonifaces, have come up with.

BILLY the Oysterman may lament the passing of the "R" months (we hear he's preparing to take up clams in a serious way), but not bouncing Billy Rose, whose *Venus on the Half-Shell* at his Diamond Horseshoe is seasonal any season. Besides assorted pulchritude, this show has the deadpandemonium of one Jackie Gleason and the zealous lunacies of bogus musician Herman Hyde. Noble Sissle's and Syd Strange's orchestras turn out tunes. "Tables" Davis hoists two tables, piled with occasional chairs, with his teeth. Our tusks, mere amateurs, are content to put the bite on Diamond Horseshoe roast beef.

WITH TULIPS and hyacinths abloom around it, the Promenade Café in Rockefeller Plaza is a right place for catching up on snorticulture . . . Titans of industry and finance confidently invest in vittles at the perfection-rife Restaurant Robert, 33 West 55th. Host Robert, their pal, is a palate pilot who'd perish sooner than give a bank president a bum steer.

STYLIZED VIEWS of Old New York, etched by artist Mareau on Plexi-glass and set in white-framed shadowboxes, accent the attractiveness of the new Lounge of the Hotel Sheraton—a soft-lit, modernist room done in burgundy, with banquettes around the walls, enfolding a paddock of small, square tables. Waitresses, shapely, operating as ele-

ments of the decoration, wear long flowing skirts of burgundy marquisette which is more opaque than mosquito netting. To keep your mind off matters that don't concern you, there's mood music by Hammond organist Bud Taylor who occasionally lends a hand to a nearby piano as well; his version of *Tico-Tico* sounds jet-propelled. Opposite, a grand has the treat of being played mighty pretty by Georgia peach Lynne James. This room's thinker-upper, Sheraton manager Gilbert Johnson, has a jackpot on his hands.

THE TREASURED custom of bringing on the girls with a song so humdrum it won't distract you from looking, has been shattered at Broadway's plush-lush Vanity Fair, where dazzling beauties—we mean dazzling—burst upon your gaze to the words and music of *My Young and Foolish Heart*, effectively sung by Bob Kennedy. You just gotta listen, much as you begrudge to. And same with the Pineapple ditty, tropical rhythmed, that crops up in the middle of things. The Vanity Fair's management (Joe Howard to you), which gets its fresh green vegetables and fresh-slaughtered poultry from its hothouses and hen-houses at Vanity Fair Farm, Northport, Long Island, got revue songs from the ace team of arranger Ted Murray and Charles "Old Lamplighter" Tobias. Bagged on the hoof, nimble tapster Hal LeRoy, who sits down and adds drumstick ticklements to his footwork, is likewise a valuable edition and a personable one. Earnestly futile Bob Williams has a dog act to end all dog acts. Slim, sly Jan Murray cracks quips. Boyd Raeburn (Esquire Award winner) and his 21-man-and-1-woman orchestra background the proceedings and play for dancing, spelled by Monchito's rumba rustlers. As for the show's star, Gertrude Niesen—Lohengrin's girl friend—her vocal and wiggle gifts, her torching, her devastating demureness, we'll buy any song she's selling, with or without the clever Hal Otis Trio (fiddle, bull edition of same, and guitar) that squires a clump of her numbers.

Frank 'Bud' Taylor Thrills Centralites With Organ Music

Frank "Bud" Taylor drew volumes of song from his audience last Thursday, February 13, when he played his electric organ in the auditorium and asked the students to sing while he played popular and old favorite songs.

Each song was introduced on the screen by brilliantly colored slides. The main theme of the singing seemed to be that of Valentine's Day. The girls were asked to sing "Stay As Sweet As You Are" to the fellows, and the latter, in turn, were asked to sing "Okay Toots" to the girls.

"Bud" introduced some of his original parodies on different songs and then after the so-called national anthem, "The Music Goes 'Round and Around," the **News** version was sung, which incidentally, was written by Theodore Marvin.

After graduating from Central in 1932, "Bud" went to Chicago where he studied at the Sherwood music school. He also studied with Mildred Fitzpatrick who was head of the American Guild of Organists. Mr. Taylor is not only adept at the organ—he has taken lessons from Doctor Keller in piano, ear training and harmony.

In 1934 "Bud" took organ lessons from Palmer Christian, instructor at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor, last spring went on a tour of Europe.

Recently "Bud" Taylor has opened the "Uptown Music Studio" in the Capitol Theatre building in conjunction with Mrs. Pearl Lory, teacher of vocal instruction.
